A Letter From the Admissions Department

On behalf of everyone here at Putnam Science Academy, we want to welcome you all to the Mustang family for the 2023-24 academic school year. The decision to join our Mustang community will help your student develop new passions, friendships, and experiences that are guaranteed to last a lifetime. Your students time here will guide, inspire, and greatly impact their future. We can not wait to greet all of you when you arrive on campus.

This welcome packet is to help make your family's transition to PSA, and to campus, smooth and seamless.

Please be sure to complete all of your student's required paperwork listed in their SchoolAdmin portal. NO STUDENT will be approved to move on to campus until all checklist items are completed and reviewed by the Admissions Department and our Director of Health.

Students will NOT BE PERMITTED to move onto campus unless their tuition accounts are up to date.

Once your student has been cleared by our Finance Department, Admissions Department, and our Health Department, you will receive an email from our Admissions Department, clearing your student to move in on move weekend (dates on next page).

All international students should have received their I-20's and Student Visa's by now. Please know that all international students MUST travel with their PSA issued I-20 as well as their government issued passport/visa. If your student has not recieved their I-20 from Putnam Science Acacemy, please contact Vaso Brodeur at vbrodeur@putnamscience.org as soon as possible.

NEW Mustang students will receive instructions on how to set up their PSA email accounts in the coming weeks. If you are experiencing difficulties setting up your student's email, please contact our IT Director Jim Weagle at jweagle@putnamscience.org.

Once their email accounts have been set up, students are required to check their PSA emails daily for important news and information. All new students will be receiving their Powerschool username and passwords from our Guidance Department during the summer months as well. This will provide them with their schedules as well as other academic information. Please be sure to log into your account to make sure you understand how to navigate the portal. If you are experiencing difficulties with Powerschool, please contact our Guidance Counselor Kelly Moulin, guidance@putnamscience.org.

Lost and/or Stolen Items:

PSA is a safe and caring environment, but like your home, it still requires forethought about protecting personal belongings. We encourage you to talk with your students about their personal belongings in their dorm rooms and keeping their doors locked at all times. Putnam Science Academy is NOT responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Lost and/or stolen items need to be reported to the Asst. Head of Schools for Student Services, Alissa Lynch, by the students within a 24-48 hour time frame after discovering the items missing, in order to properly investigate.

Information for Unaccompanied Minors:

Students designated as unaccompanied minors by the airline (generally students younger than 15 years of age, but individual guidelines vary by airlines) sometimes require special arrangements for transportation and check-in or check-out by a designated individual from the gate as they fly. We will be happy to help you with this, but would appreciate plenty of advance notice to make the proper arrangements.

On-Site Laundry Accommodations:

Students will need to purchase a \$5.00 - laundry card. These laundry cards have to be continuously replenished, so please plan accordingly when factoring in your students budget on campus. The machines only accept US dollars and can be found in all of the dormitory areas. If a student needs cash to purchase or reload their cards, we have an ATM on campus. We can also make arrangements with the Business Office to have parents send students money through their student accounts.

International Student Information:

International students are required to travel with all the required documents in order to gain entrance into the United States. (ie: valid passports, student visa's and I20's). Any new students who have previously issued I20's through another school must contact our Admissions Department ASAP to have them transferred to Putnam Science Academy.

If your student has NOT received their I20, please contact the Admissions Department ASAP.

Putnam Science Academy Dress Code

One hallmark of a prep school student is his/hers neat, clean and proper appearance. The normal dress code requires clothes to be neat, clean, and in good repair (i.e. no holes, tears, etc). All clothing should fit properly. The administrative team at Putnam Science Academy is the absolute and final arbiter of all issues surrounding the dress code. If a student is uncertain about an article of clothing, he/she should ask the Assistant Head of Schools for Student Services before wearing it or they will have to accept appropriate consequences (please refer to the Discipline section of the Student and Family Handbook).

Each student will be issued two (2) short sleeve polo's, two (2) long sleeve polo's, one (1) fleece pullover and one (1) 3-seasons jacket. Please fill out the Uniform Checklist form in this Welcome Packet and return it to Heather Stewart in the Admissions Department at hstewart@putnamscience.org.

General Appearance:

Uniforms will be handed out on Traditions Day (August 23, 2023). If a student has not arrived on campus before Traditions Day, it is their responsibility to contact our admissions department to get their uniform before they start classes. If any school issued uniform attire is ruined or lost, a replacement must be purchased through the Admissions Department.

Warm Weather Uniform:

The warm weather dress code will be in effect from the 1st day of school (August 23, 2023) through November 1, 2023 and will resume April 1, 2024 through the last day of school.

- School issued short sleeved shirt
- Black "BELTED" dress pants, belted dress shorts, skorts must be fingertip length or longer
- School issued fleece pullover or 3 seasons jacket

Cold Weather Uniform:

The cold weather dress code will be in effect from November 1, 2023 through April 1, 2024.

- School issued long sleeved shirt
- Black "BELTED" dress pants
- School issued fleece pullover or 3 seasons jacket
- Optional V-neck sweater or sweater vest from our Mustangs BSN Sideline Store here.

Belted Black Pants

Only black dress pants are to be worn as part of the every day school uniform. No denim look-alikes; decals, or lettering; no balloon pants, cargo pants, leggings/jeggings, fatigues or sweatpants are permitted. Belts or suspenders must be worn with pants; belts with studs/metal points are not permitted.

Putnam Science Academy Dress Code

Uniform Shoes:

Shoes should be solid color dress shoes (black or dark brown only) or black sneakers. Oxfords, loafers, and Mary Jane styles are acceptable in black only. Black boots may be worn, uniform pants may not be tucked into the boots.

Jackets:

PSA Jackets, winter coats, or official school issued fleece pullovers must be worn between classes in all common areas (halls, offices, etc.).

PSA Issued Photo Identification Badges:

PSA issued photo identification badges must be in the students possession at all times. Failure to have an ID badge is in violation of the dress code as well as prevents a student from entering designated buildings.

Hair:

Hair must be kept neat, clean, and well groomed at all times. Hair that obstructs a student's view must be secured in an appropriate manner so that it appears neat. Facial hair, if neat, is permitted under the discretion of the Assistant Head of Schools for Student Services (AHOS). The AHOS is the final arbiter of what is and what is not acceptable hair style. Hats or hoodies are to be worn inside school buildings. Hats worn in the building(s) may be confiscated and not returned until the last day of school.

Dress Down Guidelines:

All students are to abide by the dress code while on campus on school days. Exceptions to this policy include each Friday, where students are able to wear comfortable, appropriate clothing as long as they are wearing something PSA. This could be a t-shirt, sweatshirt, jacket, or team attire.

Other exceptions to this policy that are permitted for specified dress down days is special permission by either the Assistant Head of School for Student Services, the School Nurse or the Head of School.

In general, students are expected to maintain a neat appearance during official school dress down days. Although dress down days permit a relaxed dress code, students should still take care not to wear any clothing that distracts from the general atmosphere of the school community. This includes NO CROP TOPS, tank tops with excessive openings, or shorts/skirts less than a fingertip in length.

The Administration reserves the right to determine neatness and to interpret the dress code.

Home-stay Programs

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Putnam Science Academy impletemented a requirement for all INTERNATIONAL BOARDING STUDENTS. ALL international boarding students are required to fill out the Student Emergency Guardian form in their SchoolAdmin portals, naming a family member, friend, host family or program that will assume temporary guardianship of the student in the event of an emergency, school closing or if a student should be exposed and/or contracts COVID-19. The named party will assume responsibility for the student and remove the student from campus within a 24-48 hour time frame.
